In this report, ethnic groups with few respondents were combined as follows: (a) "Other Pacific Islander" includes Samoan, Tongan, Guamanian/Chamorro, and other Pacific Islanders not listed individually; and (b) "Other Asian" includes Japanese, Chinese, Korean, Vietnamese, Asian Indian, and other Asians not listed individually.

The Outreach Program data represent an unduplicated count of individuals who experienced literal homelessness (e.g., living in a car or park or on a beach) or were at risk for homelessness and received outreach services during the period of time, July 1, 2011–June 30, 2012.
