The majority of students are enrolled in the public school system (approx.84%), although there is a large number of students attending private schools. Nationally, the enrollment rate for public schools is about 89%, private schools 11%. The large number of private schools and students attending them may be the effect of the early establishment and rapid development of private schools in Hawai'i. Native Hawaiians during the 2010-12 school year comprised nearly 28% of the public school student population.
