- ³ Programs in following degrees and certificates were approved by the BOR: all Associates, all Baccalaureates, all Masters, all Doctorates, all Professional Practices, Certificate of Achievement (CA), Certificate in Dental Hygiene (CDH), Advanced Professional Certificate (APC), Post-Baccalaureate Certificate (PCERT), and Certificate in Teacher Ed (PDN).
- ⁴ School of Medicine reorganization effective Fall 2008: the Department of Allied Medical Sciences was reorganized into two separate departments, the Department of Medical Technology and Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology. The Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology name change to Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders approved by the President in October 2008, effective Spring 2009.
- ⁵ Myron B. Thompson School of Social Work was formerly called "School of Social Work". Name change approved by the UH Board of Regents in September 2008.
- ⁶ College of Pharmacy approved by the Board of Regents in October 2004. The inaugural class was admitted in August 2007.
- ⁷ Education division established by the Chancellor in February 2009, retroactive to Fall 2008.
