¹ Degrees conferred (counted differently from degrees earned) is the number of diplomas issued. Students who complete two or more major fields of study and are awarded the same type of degree from the same school or college are counted once for degrees conferred, but are multiple-counted for degrees earned. To illustrate, if a student received two Bachelor of Arts (BA) degrees from the College of Arts & Sciences, one in speech and another in journalism, he or she would be considered as having earned two degrees earned but only one degree conferred. When students complete more than one major field of study in different schools or colleges, or receive more than one type of degree from the same school or college, both degrees conferred and degrees earned are multiple-counted. For example, a student who received a BS in chemistry (College of Arts & Sciences) and a BS in electrical engineering (College of Engineering) would be counted once under each college, for a total of two degrees conferred and two degrees earned. Likewise, a student who received both a Bachelor of Education (BEd) degree and a Professional Diploma (PD) from the College of Education would be counted as having two degrees earned and two degrees conferred.

² The Auto Notation Credential program started in Fall 2013. Auto Notation Credentials are students who are currently enrolled at any UH CC who have completed the requirements for a lower level certificate (child certificate).

³ The Reverse Transfer program started in Fall 2013. Reverse Transfers are students who are enrolled at any UH 4-year campus who have completed the requirements for an Associate's degree.

⁴ Programs in following degrees and certificates were approved by the BOR: all Associates, all Baccalaureates, all Masters, all Doctorates, all Professional Practices, Certificate of Achievement (CA), Certificate in Dental Hygiene (CDH), Advanced Professional Certificate (APC), Post-Baccalaureate Certificate (PCERT), and Certificate in Teacher Ed (PDN).

⁵ College of Pharmacy approved by the Board of Regents in October 2004. The inaugural class was admitted in August 2007.

⁶ School of Medicine reorganization effective Fall 2008: the Department of Allied Medical Sciences was reorganized into two separate departments, the Department of Medical Technology and Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology. The Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology name change to Department of Communication Sciences and Disorders approved by the President in October 2008, effective Spring 2009.

⁷ Myron B. Thompson School of Social Work was formerly called "School of Social Work". Name change approved by the UH Board of Regents in September 2008.

⁸ Beginning in Fall 2011, PCERT students are considered to be undergraduate students at Mānoa. Therefore, they are not part of the Post-Baccalaureate counts as in prior years.
